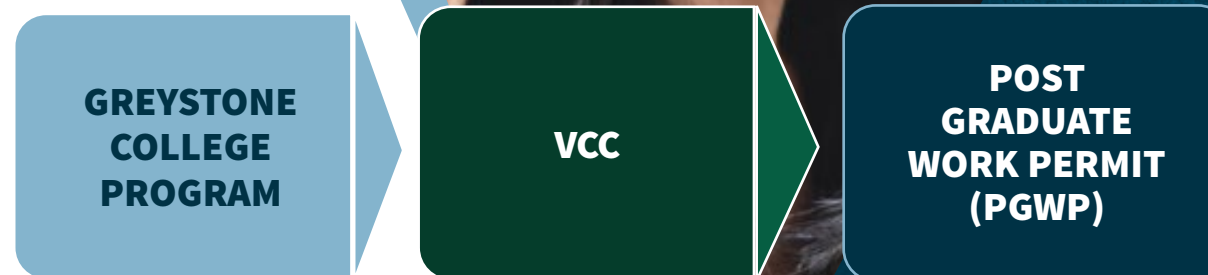
Combine quality career training and higher education with practical work experience in Canada, plus the opportunity to apply for a Post Graduate Work Permit (PGWP)!

- Transfer your Greystone College credits towards VCC programs and fast-track your learning program.
- Option to gain work experience related to your studies by choosing programs with practicum, co-op or internship components.
- Apply for both programs through Greystone College – you will receive admission to Greystone College and conditional admission to VCC at the same time to apply for your study permit.
- Option to apply for a Post Graduate Work Permit at the end of your VCC program– your PGWP could be valid for between 1-3 years!*
