Entry Requirement

- Students who are interested in attending Greystone College must have a secondary school diploma, GED or mature student status.
- All applicants whose first language is not English must demonstrate an Intermediate 3 level of English with Greystone College's online written and speaking test.

The online written and speaking test is exempt if TOEFL iBT 46, IELTS 5.5 or ILSC Intermediate 3 is presented.

If an applicant fails to meet the minimum requirements, they cannot be waived by either the institution or the student.

Students who complete both the TESOL TKT Certificate, and the TKT-YL Certificate will earn the Cambridge TESOL Diploma. Graduates of the program will leave with the skills and knowledge required for teaching English to Adults and Young Learners.

TESOL-TKT Certificate 4 weeks

TKT-Young Learners Certificate 4 weeks

Gain the knowledge, strategies and skills required to teach and engage young learners. TKT-Young Learners is ideal if you are an international teacher working, or intending to work, in the primary sector of education. Students will gain an understanding of lesson planning, different teaching strategies and learner assessment.
