## LIVE

Students experience local culture by staying with an ILSC homestay family.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Single

**BATHROOMS:** Shared

**AMENITIES:** Laundry machines and wireless internet provided

**AVERAGE TRAVEL DISTANCE FROM HOMESTAY TO CAMPUS:** 45-60 minutes

**ESTIMATED PUBLIC TRANSPORT FEES:**  
\$45 CAD/week

**MEALS:** 3 meals per day

*All of our homestay families provide our young students with detailed instructions on how to travel from the homestay to our downtown ILSC locations. Students also receive a 24-hour emergency phone contact should they require additional support.*

*Day-only options are available for students who may be residing with family in Montréal. This option includes English or French language lessons and activity programming. Please inquire regarding pricing for this program option.*



## EXPLORE

Students enjoy an activities program that combines morning field trips and a full-day excursion every Saturday.

**MORNING ACTIVITIES:** Students will connect with other international students, build friendships, and experience Canadian culture while participating in fun activities that include visiting local attractions, sports, and games.

**WEEKEND ACTIVITIES:** Students enjoy a full-day excursion on Saturday. On Sunday, they spend the day with their homestay family.

*Specific trip destinations vary depending on the students' attendance dates.*

Classes take place at our downtown ILSC campus location.

**LANGUAGE OF STUDY:** English or French

**NUMBER OF LANGUAGE LEVELS:** 5

**NUMBER OF LESSONS:** 16.5 (13.75 hrs/week)

**GENERAL ENGLISH CONTENT:** Our Juniors English language curriculum reflects current, real-world issues, recent events, social and environmental issues, popular culture, so that the content is relatable and interesting for teens. The Juniors English language program focuses on several areas including Canadian culture, reading, speaking, and writing.

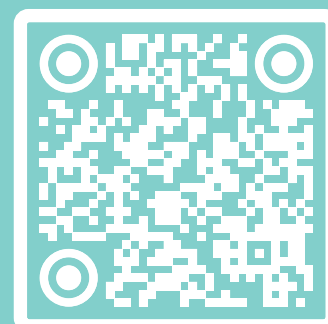
**SKILLS PLUS CONTENT:** Students at the Intermediate 2 level or higher can opt to replace their English class with the *Leadership* class - develop students' essential leadership skills such as critical thinking, communication, empathy, and cultural awareness to become confident and compassionate leaders in their schools, communities, and beyond.\*

**TUITION SCHEDULE:** Monday to Friday from 2:30 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.

**CERTIFICATE:** End of course certificate and student progress reports provided.

*\*Skills Plus: Leadership class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 6 - 26). Skills Plus is taken instead of General English or French. This option requires a minimum level of Intermediate 2 and is only available in English.*

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
