## NEW! SKILLS PLUS OPTION: DRAMA AND PERFORMANCE

**Entry Level: Beginner 4+**

Level up your English learning and explore a topic that matches your interests, talents, and goals! The Drama and Performance class introduces students to the world of English theatre and performance arts and improves their English communication skills through acting and scriptwriting.

*The Drama and Performance class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 7 - 27). Students who choose this option take it instead of General English classes (the class is only available in English).*



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## LIVE

Students live and dine within the Royal Victoria College Residence.

Classes take place at our downtown ILSC campus location.

**LANGUAGE OF STUDY:** English or French

**NUMBER OF LANGUAGE LEVELS:** 5

**NUMBER OF LESSONS:** 16.5 (13.75 hrs/week)

**NUMBER OF STUDENTS PER CLASS:** 16 max

**GENERAL ENGLISH CONTENT:** Our Juniors English language curriculum reflects current, real-world issues, recent events, social and environmental issues, popular culture, and events so that the content is relatable and interesting for teens. The Juniors English language program focuses on several areas including Canadian culture, reading, speaking, and writing.

**SKILLS PLUS CONTENT:** Students at the Beginner 4+ level or higher can opt to replace their English class with the **Drama and Performance Skills Plus** class, which introduces students to the world of English theatre and performance arts and improves their English communication skills through acting and scriptwriting.

**TUITION SCHEDULE:** Monday to Friday from 2:30 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.

**CERTIFICATE:** End of course certificate and student progress reports provided

## EXPLORE

Students enjoy an activities program that combines off-site field trips and on-campus evening activities.

**MORNING PROGRAMMING:** Students enjoy activities that include visits to local attractions, sports and games.

**EVENING ACTIVITIES:** Activities include scavenger hunts, sports evenings, student performances and dance parties.

**WEEKEND ACTIVITIES:** Students enjoy full-day excursions on Saturdays and Sundays.

**SKILLS PLUS ACTIVITIES:** Students who choose Skills Plus will enjoy 2 morning activities per week within the off-site activities slot, specifically related to their Skills Plus area of study.\*\*

Specific trip destinations vary depending on the students' attendance dates.

*\*\*Skills Plus: Drama and Performance class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 7 - 27). Skills Plus is taken instead of General English. This option requires a minimum level of Beginner 4 or higher.*
