

GENERAL ENGLISH CONTENT: Our Juniors English language curriculum reflects current, real-world issues, recent events, social and environmental issues, popular culture, and events so that the content is relatable and interesting for teens. The Juniors English language program focuses on several areas including Canadian culture, reading, speaking, and writing.

**SKILLS PLUS CONTENT:** Students at the Intermediate 2 level or higher can opt to replace their English class with the *Leadership* class - develop students' essential leadership skills such as critical thinking, communication, empathy, and cultural awareness to become confident and compassionate leaders in their schools, communities, and beyond.\*

**TUITION SCHEDULE:** Monday to Friday from 2:30 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.

**CERTIFICATE:** End of course certificate and student progress reports provided.

\*Skills Plus: Leadership class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 6 - 26). Skills Plus is taken instead of General English or French. This option requires a minimum level of Intermediate 2 and is only available in English.
