NEW! SKILLS PLUS OPTION: GLOBAL LEADERSHIP

Entry Level: Intermediate 2+

Level up your English learning and explore a topic that matches your interests, talents, and goals! The Global Leadership class equips students with essential leadership skills such as critical thinking, communication, empathy, and cultural awareness.

The Global Leadership class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 7 - 27). Students who choose this option take it instead of General English classes.

Students experience local culture by staying with an ILSC homestay family.

Classes take place at our downtown ILSC campus location.

GENERAL ENGLISH CONTENT: Our Juniors English language curriculum reflects current, real-world issues, recent events, social and environmental issues, and popular culture, so that the content is relatable and interesting for teens. The Juniors English language program focuses on several areas including Canadian culture, reading, speaking, and writing.

SKILLS PLUS CONTENT: Students at the Intermediate 2 level or higher can opt to replace their English class with the Global Leadership class - develop essential leadership skills such as critical thinking, communication, empathy, and cultural awareness.

TUITION SCHEDULE: Monday to Friday from 2:30 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.

CERTIFICATE: End of course certificate and student progress reports provided.



EXPLORE

Students enjoy an activities program that combines morning field trips and a full-day excursion every Saturday.

MORNING ACTIVITIES: Students will connect with other international students, build friendships, and experience Canadian culture while participating in fun activities that include visiting local attractions, sports, and games.

SKILLS PLUS ACTIVITIES: Students who choose Skills Plus will enjoy two morning activities per week, specifically related to their Skills Plus area of study.*

WEEKEND ACTIVITIES: On Saturdays, students will enjoy a full-day excursion to Niagara Falls, Canada's Wonderland and other exciting sites. On Sundays, Juniors Program students will enjoy an immersive cultural experience with their homestay family.

**Skills Plus: The Global Leadership class option is available during weeks 2, 3, and 4 of the program for an additional fee (July 7 - 27). Skills Plus is taken instead of General English. This option requires a minimum level of Intermediate 2.*
