- Blended learning program includes ILSC courses delivered in school and a set study block to complete TVO ILC's online high school credit program in ILSC's computer labs.

DESCRIPTION

Enrich your educational experience by earning internationally recognized high school courses from TVO ILC, along with the language and academic skills you need to succeed in your personal academic journey. This program includes English for Academic Purposes or ESL-High School Bridge program classes taught by ILSC teachers, combined with TVO ILC's online Ontario high school credit programs. Available credit courses include:

Grade 9:	English (ENG1D), Principles of Mathematics (MPM1D), Science (SNC1D)
Grade 10:	English (ENG2D), Foundations of Mathematics (MFM2P), Principles of Mathematics (MPM2D), Science (SNC2D)
Grade 11:	English (ENG3U), Functions (MCR3U), Functions and Applications (MCF3M), Environmental Science (SVN3M), Biology (SBI3U), Physics (SPH3U), Chemistry (SCH3U)
Grade 12:	English (ENG4U), Mathematics of Data Management (MDM4U), Calculus and Vectors (MCV4U), Advanced Functions (MHF4U), Science (SNC4M), Physics (SPH4U), Earth and Space Sciences (SES4U), Chemistry (SCH4U), Biology (SBI4U)

THE SUPPORT YOU NEED TO SUCCEED

In addition to daily ILSC English for Academic Purposes (EAP) or ESL-High School Bridge classes, and dedicated time slots for independent study of the online high school credit material, students receive a range of support services to ensure their success:

- High school credit (1 course equals 1 credit and is estimated at 110 study hours)
- 55-80 hours of language study per
- Weekly small group support and check-in sessions with ILSC session
- All required materials
- ILSC Certificate of Completion

SCHEDULES

Students age 16+ can choose either the Full-Time Morning or Part-Time Morning schedule for their language study. Students age 12-15 can take the Full-Time Morning, ESL-High School Bridge program. A part-time schedule is ideal for direct entry students seeking one or more credits. A full-time schedule is recommended for ILSC University Pathway students seeking one or more individual credits.

*Time allocated to the TVO ILC High School Program credit portion is self-directed and flexible. A minimum of 20 hours of study time per week is required for completion of one credit within 8 weeks.

SEAMLESS ENTRY

For students wishing to take advantage of our ILSC University Pathway Program seamless entry (no IELTS or TOEFL test required), we recommend registering for two sessions of our Full Time Intensive schedule following the completion of your Individual High School Credit(s).
