# **ENTRY REQUIREMENT**

#### **Social Volunteer Internship**

A minimum of **ILSC Intermediate 2** is required two weeks prior to internship start date

NOTE: The maximum length of the placement depends on the host company or organization and the student's own schedule.

# Minimum 4 weeks Full-Time Intensive study + 4 weeks Internship

# **DESCRIPTION**

The Social Volunteer Internship Program is an innovative model of enriched education combining English language studies with volunteer experience in the Indian community. Students are placed in a social Volunteer Internship helping disadvantaged Indians in New Delhi, or in small countryside villages.

#### **FULL-TIME INTENSIVE STUDY**

Take a minimum of 4 weeks Full-Time Intensive study, and improve your language skills in preparation for your success in your Internship. Choose courses like:

- English Communication
- Business English
- Test Preparation (IELTS, TOEFL or TOEIC)
- Basic Hindi

Foundation courses may apply depending on your background and experience.

# VOLUNTEER INTERNSHIP

- Volunteer to work with disadvantaged children, women, the disabled or handicapped, or the elderly
- Students can also participate in village infrastructure projects
- Experience village life and gain exposure to international development
- Students must be prepared to live and work outside of Delhi, in Himachel, Pradesh, Rajasthan or Goa
- Minimum 4 weeks of unpaid internship

# **REGISTRATION**

#### STEP ONE

Take the Pre-Registration Online Language Assessment (PROLA) and do a phone interview. (Students registered in 24-week and longer Full-Time Intensive study may be exempt from the PROLA and the phone interview)

# STEP TWO

Complete the ILSC application form, and the Volunteer Internship Program application form and send the program fees to the school.

# STEP THREE

Submit both application forms, a curriculum vitae (CV) and a cover letter. The CV should be neat and professional and include all relevant educational and work experience. The cover letter should state your skills and placement goals.
